Dates "Deglet" & Dried Fruits

Presentation

Tunisia is considered to be one of the largest producers of dates in the world, a Mediterranean country par excellence, it has a dry and hot climate in its oases that promotes culture of the date palm.

About 150 varieties of dates are cultivated in the palm plantations of the south that form the typical vegetation of oases and are concentrated in the oases of the Djerid (Tozeur) and Nefzewa (Kebili). Deglet Nour is the noble variety par excellence and the date of in terms of quality:

Deglet Nour literally "light finger" in Arabic is the best known and most consumed variety appreciated for its energy value twice superior to other varieties and its translucent blond color that we nicknamed "dates of the sun and light".

It is the sweet, fleshy fruit (in botany: a Bay) that measures approximately 5cm of length and which can be sold under dried shape, most of the time, or freshly. Fruit particularly energy, referring at his hour vitamin C content and in carbohydrates. Furthermore, it is in a good source of fibers.





Pistachios

The pistachio is a nut, produced by a mediterranean shrub Latin name Pistacia Vera L. from the Family of Anacardiaceae.

It comes in the form of a small greenish in color and sweet flavor seed, housed in a shell that opens when the fruit is ripe.

It contains carbohydrates, lipids, proteins, fiber, phosphorus, potassium, thiamine, vitamin (B-6 EA and K), beta-carotene, lutein, calcium, iron, magnesium, zinc folic acid ...

Almond

The almond tree origin is from hot and dry regions near the Middle East, consumed for more than 3000 years.

It has been revealed that during the conquest of Spain, the Arabs brought with them core citrus seed they planted almonds. The almond spread all along the coast of the Mediterranean, especially in Tunisia. Almond got its name from the Latin name Prunus amygdalus either sweet or bitter, it is a fruit shell, oleaginous grain to the pulpit pale, crisp, can be sweet or bitter (wild variety).

It is a walnut with a large nutritional importance because of its richness in phytosterols, monounsaturated fatty acids, protein, fiber, vitamin (B1, B2, B3 and E), magnesium, manganese, copper, phosphorus, iron, zinc, calcium and potassium.
